**Mayor Cariker called the meeting to order at 9:00.**

**The Board discussed the purchase of a new meat grinder for the grocery store. Mayor Cariker advised that repairs on the old grinder were quoted at \$7,845.00; a new grinder would cost \$14,672.00 with a one year warranty for parts and labor. Both quotes are from Hobart Sales. The Board discussed past due rent owed by James Jeffcoat, but decided that the lack of a grinder would further hinder his ability to pay rent. After discussion, Alderman Willis made the motion to approve the purchase of a new grinder. Alderman Graves seconded and the motion was unanimously adopted.**

**Regarding the old grinder, Alderman Beach made a motion to declare that equipment surplus and authorized the Mayor to put it out for bids. Alderwoman Taylor seconded and the motion was unanimously adopted.**

**Upon motion by Alderman Beach and seconded by Alderman Dulaney, the meeting recessed at 9:07 a.m. this 15<sup>th</sup> day of November.**
